

Skill Building Courses, Grades 8-9

This program is designed for school-age students who meet the following criteria:

- have taken the course during the 2022/2023 school year
- their competency is emerging or low developing (35%-62%)
(students with competencies that include high developing, proficient, extending, or higher than 62% may benefit more from taking a Preview Enrichment Course)
- would like to strengthen their skills in the course

Skill Building courses are 40 hours in duration and will focus on the understanding of key big ideas and competencies and will NOT cover the entire scope of courses.

Students completing the course will receive an assessment using the proficiency scales (this will not include a percent or letter grade)

- Start Date: Thursday, July 6, 2023; End Date: Wednesday, August 2, 2023, Monday through Friday
- 20 sessions per course
- Block One → 8:15 - 10:15 am // Block Two → 10:45 am - 12:45 pm
- School: a Richmond School District secondary school to be determined
