4. PRINCIPAL'S REPORT (Ms. Annie Varghese)

- a. Breakfast With Santa coming up on 17Dec2021
 - Will be an alternate bell schedule; a bit of a hybrid this year vs. the traditional Breakfast With Santa
 - Gr.8-11: will receive Christmas Goodie Bags (muffin, candy cane, juice box, chocolates, mandarin oranges); supplied in partnership with SLSS admin, StuCo, & PAC, and packed by parent volunteers
 - Gr.12 only (due to capacity limitations): will get Pancake Breakfast; made by Shark Bites staff and served by parent volunteers
 - Breakfast With Santa video presentation (not live) will take place in the gym for Gr.12 and in block C classrooms for Gr.8-11
- b. Christmas Break
 - heading into Winter break soon; reminding students to remain focussed on their school work
 - semester end will occur quickly after Christmas Break (only 3 weeks after!)
- c. Conference Day
 - occurred virtually on 01Dec2021 for about 2 hours, not an entire day conference because unsure if could have presenters coming in-person
 - 2 themes: 1) What is diversity? 2) Why do we value diversity at SLSS?
 - had 2 presenters come to share experiences about being visually-impaired
 - next Conference Day will be later in Spring 2022
- d. Volleyball Provincial Championship
 - SLSS hosting today and Friday on short notice (should have been in Kelowna but moved here due to weather, flooding, road conditions)
 - SLSS Sr. Boys team qualified for the tournament
 - COVID safety protocols being followed; limited to 25 guest passes per team
