 - i. a way to provide info to families about student progress and reporting
 - ii. teachers will assess students and communicate to parents & students on what the next steps in learning that students should be taking
 - iii. may eventually replace letter grades and percentages
 - b. Four stages in respect to understanding of the concepts & competencies relevant to the expected learning
 - i. Emerging
 - The student demonstrates an initial understanding
 - ii. Developing
 - The student demonstrates a partial understanding
 - iii. Proficient
 - The student demonstrates a complete understanding
 - iv. Extending
 - The student demonstrates a sophisticated understanding
 - c. The above descriptors DO NOT directly correspond to letter grades
 - d. It is projected that Proficiency Scales will be used for Grades 8 & 9 reporting starting Sept 2022.
 - e. No information is available at the moment about what will happen to Grades 10, 11 & 12s or what will happen to university admission.
