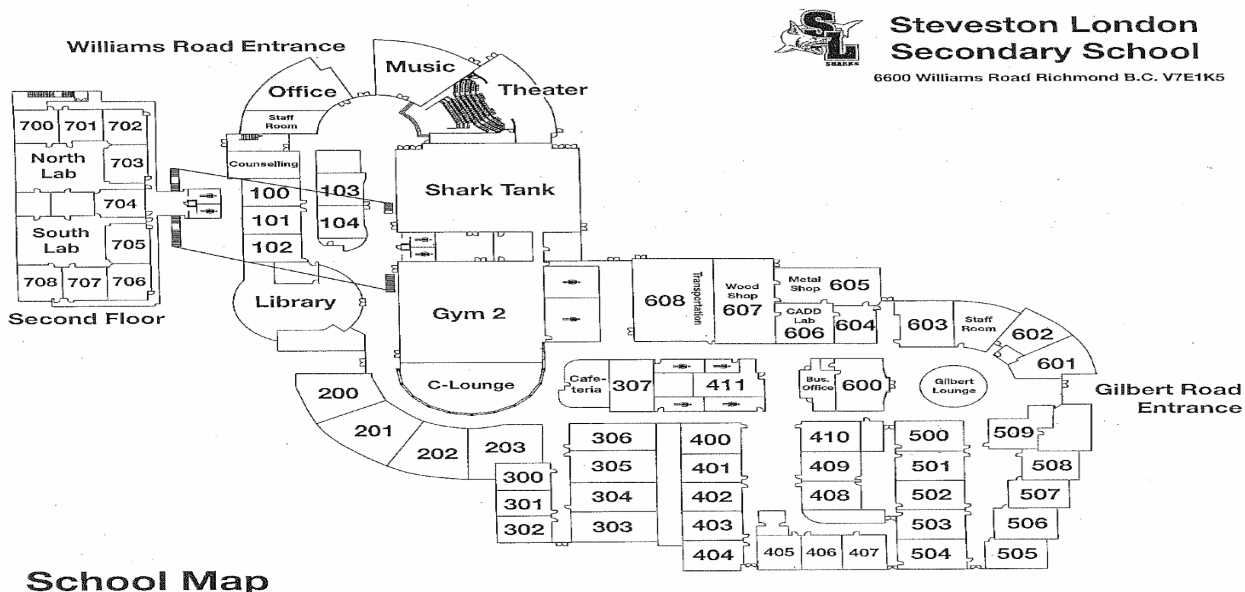

Steveston-London Secondary School

Steveston-London Secondary School opened in 2007 after the merger of two outstanding schools - Steveston High (est. 1956) and Charles E. London Secondary (est. 1974). The legacy of academic and extracurricular excellence established by the two former schools served as a tremendous foundation to build an exciting new place for students. The class of 2023 will be the 16th graduating class at Steveston-London and the 74th in our proud history.



Steveston-London Secondary School is organized on the semester system. Students are enrolled in four classes from September to January and four different classes from February to June. The 2022-23 enrollment is 1126 students from Grades 8-12.

Steveston-London grads have already established a legacy of outstanding academic achievement. SLSS students have consistently achieved recognition for academic excellence. Hundreds of grads have gone directly to university or college after graduating from Steveston-London and many have received prestigious entrance scholarships to the top universities in North America.

Steveston-London also offers a wide range of elective programs to meet the needs of *all* our students. Opportunities to learn and explore art, drama, music, food studies, fashion design, technology/CADD, metal art, automotive, information technology, business & marketing, physical education, leadership, recording arts, and engineering are all part of the SLSS experience.

Steveston-London offers an extensive extracurricular program with the goal of a very high student participation rate in clubs, athletics, theatre and music. Over the years, "Packers" and "Legends" teams were District, Lower Mainland and Provincial champions in many sports and the "Sharks" are carrying on these strong traditions. Intramural games and open gym for fun and fitness are available to all students at lunch.

Social responsibility and the themes of *care* and *respect* are a big part of the student experience at SLSS. In all we do, we demonstrate care and respect – for ourselves, for other students, including those who appear different than us, for our school, for our community and for our planet. We provide opportunities for students to join, volunteer or lead in over 40 clubs and get positively connected and engaged in school, community and global events & issues.

SLSS students learn in a building that features a state-of-the-art science wing with two super-labs, a library-commons with a student computer center, two full-sized gymnasiums and a separate weight room, 168-seat theatre, dedicated music and arts studios and many renovated classrooms and technology areas. Our building and facilities provide a tremendous environment for students to learn, to grow and to succeed.
