4. PRINCIPAL'S REPORT (*Ms. Annie Varghese*)

- a. Breakfast for Santa is on Friday, December 16. Unlike last year, where the event was hybrid, this year, the event is fully in-person. Breakfast and performances will start at 7:30am. Classes will follow and students will be dismissed at 1:30pm.
- b. January 26, 2023 is the end of Semester 1. January 27 is semester turnaround day and there will be no classes. January 30 is Pro-D Day and January 31 will be the first day of Semester 2.
- c. Grad assessments are to be completed the last week of January. Both GLA 10 and GLA 12 will be held in January.
- d. Grade 12's boat cruise and winter formal are being finalized. Grad fees are collected online this year, and this is much easier for the parents and the school.

 - Bank balance on November 4 was \$36,523.21 There were no deposits. We were charged \$8.75 bank fees but by switching to paperless statement, we will be saving \$5 per month starting January 2023. The balance on December 6 was \$36,514.46.
