#### ELIGIBILITY, APPLICATION AND SELECTION PROCESS

Application Deadline: MAY 1st of Graduating Year

The PAC offers one or more financial scholarships to Steveston-London Secondary School students graduating from grade 12, in recognition of their volunteer service in the school and/or community.

The scholarship money awarded is to be used by students in support of attending an accredited college, university, trade or technical school, or any post-secondary education program, within 12 months following graduation.

#### **Application Process and Deadline**

Students must apply using the below Application Form and include the specified essay and letter of recommendation, written specifically for this scholarship application (copies of recommendation letters for college/university admission will not be accepted).

The application deadline is MAY 1<sup>st</sup> of the graduating year. Applications will not be considered after that date or if the essay or recommendation letter is not included.

Applications are to be in a sealed envelope marked 'Attention – Steveston-London PAC Scholarship Committee' and may be hand delivered or mailed to the school office, or placed in the PAC box. (Applications by facsimiles or email will not be accepted.)

#### Qualification and Selection for Award

The scholarships are in recognition of students' volunteer services either in the school, including assisting in support of PAC events, or in the community. Scholarships do not have a GPA requirement. The awarding of the scholarships will based on the PAC Scholarship Committee's assessment of meritorious volunteer service. Student applications and the Committee's assessments thereof will be treated in a confidential manner.

Scholarship recipients will be notified by letter and the scholarships announced and presented at the school's Scholarship Awards Night event (with cheques issued thereafter).

(!) **Note:** The award of a scholarship does not create a right by the student to the amount of the award, and if a cheque is not deposited by a student within six months of issuance, the PAC serves the right to cancel the cheque and withdraw the award of the scholarship.
