Recent experience in a leadership role that involved the planning, development, and delivery of a program for younger students (Ex: 2 weeks as a full day camp leader at a community centre with relevant responsibilities)

Commitment to planning and implementing events Demonstrated ability to share/teach a skill and/or concept Demonstrated ability to work as a member in a team environment Demonstrated ability to be a good problem solver Good attendance at school And other unique qualities that may be relevant to our grade 8s
