- 6. RICHMOND DISTRICT PARENTS ASSOCIATION REPORT (Mr. Volker Helmuth)
  - a. The DPAC met on December 5th.
  - b. Richmond Board of Education Chairperson Heather Larson attended, introduced herself to the DPAC and provide an overview of the role of the Board. The Board is the elected oversight body that hires the Superintendent, disperses the budget allocated by the Province, and seeks to ensure the effective and efficient administration of schools in Richmond. The Board has no role in determining the educational curriculum, as that is done by the Province through the Ministry of Education. Chair Larson was asked and responded to various questions from DPAC members.
