4. PRINCIPAL'S REPORT (Ms. Annie Varghese)

- a. Tomorrow afternoon is second semester's meet the teacher
- b. Feb 23 is Grade 9's Social Responsibility Day
- c. Progress report will be sent out later this month for Semester 2
- d. There was a presentation yesterday on Consent for all students: what is consent, words used, the law, age for giving consent, how to protect yourself in unsafe situations, how friends can help each other in unsafe situations; the creation, distribution, sharing of pictures, and what the law says about that.
