RIE ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP

Scholarship Eligibility

- must be a Richmond School District International Student;
- will be graduating from a Richmond public secondary school in the year of scholarship application;
- will be pursuing full time public post-secondary study in British Columbia/Canada; and
- Registration to the post-secondary institution must be completed within 18 months of the secondary school graduation date.

Criteria

- based on the average of academic achievement in the top six subjects from the Graduation Program taken during the final year of study at a Richmond public secondary school.
- The eligible courses must be Grade 11 or 12, and be completed at the home school(s)
- Marks must be based on the prior term and on the mid Term Report (Semester Program) or the Term 2 Report (Linear Program)

Selection Process

Selection of the successful applicant(s) will be the responsibility of the RIE Screening Committee. The amount of the scholarship will be a maximum of \$1,000 each for up to two scholarships based on the quality of applications. The awarding of either one or two scholarships will be left to the discretion of the RIE selection panel.

Application Deadline

All candidates must submit their completed applications by Friday, May 3, 2024 at 4:00pm. Winner(s) will be announced May 10, 2024.

RIE ALL-ROUND STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP

Scholarship Eligibility

- must be a Richmond School District International Student;
- will be graduating from a Richmond public secondary school in the same year;
- will be pursuing full time public post-secondary study in British Columbia; and
- Registration to the post-secondary institution must be completed within 18 months of the secondary school graduation date.

Criteria

- based on the average of academic achievement in the top six subjects from the Graduation Program taken during the final year of study at a Richmond public secondary school.
- The eligible courses must be Grade 11 or 12, and be completed at the home school(s)
- Marks must be based on the prior term and on the mid Term Report (Semester Program) or the Term 2 Report (Linear Program)

In addition students will demonstrate:

- an interest in service to others
- their active participation in school and/or community activities
- good citizenship and leadership within the school and/or community

Selection Process

Selection of the successful applicant(s) will be the responsibility of the RIE Screening Committee. The amount of the scholarship will be a maximum of \$1,000 each for up to two scholarships based on the quality of applications. The awarding of either one or two scholarships will be left to the discretion of the RIE selection panel.
