January 5	Program Planning Guide is published on the school website
January 12 9:43-10:31am	Program Planning Information Session (during PLT) for: - Grade 8's going into Grade 9 (in the Shark Tank) - Grade 11's going into Grade 12 (in the Theatre)
January 14 9:43-10:31am	Program Planning Information Session (during Connections Class) for: - Grade 9's going into Grade 10 (in the Shark Tank) - Grade 10's going into Grade 11 (in the Theatre)
January 15 6-7pm	A Program Planning Parent Information Evening will be held virtually on Microsoft Teams and will be hosted by our school counsellors. Families will receive an email with the session details and meeting links .
January 21 6-7pm	Administrators and counsellors will host an in-person information session for Grade 7 parents at SLSS in the Legends Gym .
January 19-27	SLSS counsellors will visit all feeder elementary schools, and Grade 7 students and their parents will receive a digital Program Planning Form to complete.
January 26	Grade 7 students and their families will complete course selections for Grade 8 using a Microsoft Teams form .
January 26	Program Planning Portal Opens – Students will be able to log in to MyEdBC and begin selecting their courses.
January 26-27	Optional Program Planning Course Selection support for current Grade 8 students entering Grade 9 will be offered over these two days. Students will receive an email with their assigned date and time .
February 17	Deadline for Grade 7 students to submit their course selections using the Microsoft Teams form emailed to families.
February 17	Program Planning Portal Closes – This is the final day for students to log in to MyEdBC to select or make changes to their course selections for the next school year. Please remember to click “Post” before logging out.
April	Course Verification and Final Changes – In April, students will be asked to review the courses they selected in MyEdBC during the program planning process. Any final course change requests can be submitted using an MS Teams form , which will be emailed to students at that time.
June	Student Schedules – Students will receive their school schedules for the next year by the end of June. The schedules will list the classes for each semester but will not include room numbers or teacher assignments.
September	New School Year Schedules – Students will begin the new school year following the schedules posted on MyEdBC.
