<b>January 5</b>	Program Planning Guide is published on the school website
<b>January 12</b> 9:43-10:31am	Program Planning Information Session (during PLT) for: - <b>Grade 8's going into Grade 9</b> (in the Shark Tank) - <b>Grade 11's going into Grade 12</b> (in the Theatre)
<b>January 14</b> 9:43-10:31am	Program Planning Information Session (during Connections Class) for: - <b>Grade 9's going into Grade 10</b> (in the Shark Tank) - <b>Grade 10's going into Grade 11</b> (in the Theatre)
<b>January 15</b> 6-7pm	A <b>Program Planning Parent Information Evening</b> will be held <b>virtually on Microsoft Teams</b> and will be hosted by our school counsellors. Families will receive an email with the <b>session details and meeting links</b> .
<b>January 21</b> 6-7pm	Administrators and counsellors will host an <b>in-person information session for Grade 7 parents</b> at SLSS in the <b>Legends Gym</b> .
<b>January 19-27</b>	SLSS counsellors will visit all feeder elementary schools, and Grade 7 students and their parents will receive a <b>digital Program Planning Form</b> to complete.
<b>January 26</b>	Grade 7 students and their families will complete course selections for Grade 8 using a <b>Microsoft Teams form</b> .
<b>January 26</b>	<b>Program Planning Portal Opens</b> – Students will be able to log in to <b>MyEdBC</b> and begin selecting their courses.
<b>January 26-27</b>	<b>Optional Program Planning Course Selection support</b> for current Grade 8 students entering Grade 9 will be offered over these two days. Students will receive an email with their <b>assigned date and time</b> .
<b>February 17</b>	<b>Deadline for Grade 7 students</b> to submit their course selections using the <b>Microsoft Teams form</b> emailed to families.
<b>February 17</b>	<b>Program Planning Portal Closes</b> – This is the final day for students to log in to <b>MyEdBC</b> to select or make changes to their course selections for the next school year. Please remember to click <b>"Post"</b> before logging out.
<b>April</b>	<b>Course Verification and Final Changes</b> – In April, students will be asked to review the courses they selected in MyEdBC during the program planning process. Any final course change requests can be submitted using an <b>MS Teams form</b> , which will be emailed to students at that time.
<b>June</b>	<b>Student Schedules</b> – Students will receive their school schedules for the next year by the end of June. The schedules will list the classes for each semester but will <b>not</b> include room numbers or teacher assignments.
<b>September</b>	<b>New School Year Schedules</b> – Students will begin the new school year following the schedules posted on MyEdBC.
