Student Expectations:

Dress Code: School appropriate.

Bring Photo ID to check-in. Security will be checking guests upon entrance to the boat. **If you have a toonie (or more) to put towards your Graduating Class' scholarship gift for next year, please bring one.**

Arrival: Boarding at 6:30pm. Ship sails at 7:00pm sharp. **Grads will have to leave Richmond before 5pm to ensure arrival at the Harbour on time.** The boat will **not** wait for grads arriving late. If you arrive late and miss the boat, there will be no refund.

Parking: There is limited outdoor parking lot near the harbour at the Plaza of Nations. Pay parking is in effect. The outdoor parking lot accepts credit card payments and the pay-by-phone option.

Return to Dock: The boat will arrive back at the dock at 10:00pm. Please ensure all safe rides to pick you up arrive there no later than 10:00pm.

Behaviour: This is a school event, and all school and district rules and expectations apply. The use or possess alcohol or any other prohibited substances will result in students being sent home with a parent or guardian (without a refund), and the application of school-based consequences which may include suspension and exclusion from future grad events.
