Bell Schedule – Regular schedule

Our bell schedule will be different as the PLT schedule has changed for this school year. PLT is an hour long and will occur on Wednesdays and Thursdays after the first period of the day. Personal Digital Device Expectations

Students are reminded of the personal digital devices expectations that are in place for secondary schools:

- Students should not use personal digital devices during instructional time, unless permission is granted by the supervising staff for educational purposes.
- When not permitted, personal digital devices should be powered off and secured inside a student's backpack, locker or secured location.

Personal Learning Time (PLT)

Students have the opportunity again this year to engage in weekly Personal Learning Time (PLT) on Wednesdays and Thursdays from 9:41-10:41am. This is dedicated time integrated into our regular school schedule, where students are given choice and ownership over their learning. The goal of PLT is to teach students the skills necessary to use instructional time in a way that benefits their individual learning. All students will be expected to sign up for PLT sessions with any one of their teachers who are available or any other teacher who has availability – the sign-up process will be communicated to them in their homeroom class during the second week of school. We encourage students to utilize their PLT time to get additional help, work on projects individually or in a group, or engage in personal activities such as goal setting. Please note that PLT will begin on September 16th. Attendance during PLT is mandatory for all students and teachers will be taking attendance for each session. **All students will attend PLT in their homerooms on September 16th and 17th to learn more about the new PLT structure, expectations, and sign-up.**

Forms to be Completed and Returned by Friday, September 11th

- Personalized Student Information Verification Form:* The medical information is invaluable in the event of an emergency at the school. Accurate email addresses and phone numbers for the school's records are very important as email is used for report cards, WAAGs, and attendance reporting in the Richmond School District.
- Personal Information Consent Form:* Permission is needed for the school to send parents/guardians important information via email and for the school to include a student's name or image in the yearbook, newsletters, on the school's website and/or social media.
- Outdoor Classroom and Walking Field Trip Form:* Permission is needed for students to participate in outdoor classrooms and walking field trips throughout the year.

All 3 forms will be distributed to students on September 8th. Please complete these forms and return them to the drop box located outside the main office in the Williams Lounge by Friday, September 11th.

Student Schedules

Please note that Grade 9-12 students may log on to MyEd BC starting on Monday, September 7th and view their schedules. Grade 8's and all new students will only receive their MyEd BC access later in September – *Grade 8s should communicate their personal email address with their HR teacher or the office.* Please note that timetables may change, as counsellors work to ensure that all students have complete timetables and all the required courses. Students' timetables will be distributed to them on Tuesday, September 8th during their homeroom classes. For course corrections, students should use the QR code found on the schedule they will receive. The QR code is also posted on the front office door and on the counselling centre door. The deadline for students to submit this online form is Monday, September 14th at 3:30pm. Counsellors will not be able to consider requests for course changes made via email, so please be sure to fill out the online form. **Please note that timetable changes are prioritized for students with incomplete schedules and/or to ensure that students meet graduation requirements.**

School Fees – SchoolCashOnline

The District Standardized School Fee, and Yearbook fee has been applied to your child's account. Please note that purchasing a yearbook is optional for students. Grade 8 Adventure Days fee is available for payment. Grade 12 students will see additional fees on their account based on Grad events offered throughout the school year.
