Student Expectations:

Dress Code: Semi-Formal

Bring Photo ID to check in. Security will be checking guests upon entrance to the venue.

Arrival: Doors open at 6:00pm and close at 6:30pm. **Grads will not be able to enter after 6:30pm, unless prior arrangements have been made with the Administration.**

Departure: **Grads, please arrange for rides to arrive by 10:30pm sharp or earlier. Grads should be picked up when the event concludes at 10:30pm.** If a student chooses to leave early, they will not be permitted to go back into the event. There will be no "in and out" privileges. Parents, please be advised that you must make arrangements with your child if they choose to leave early, as the school will not be contacting you if your child chooses to leave the event early.
